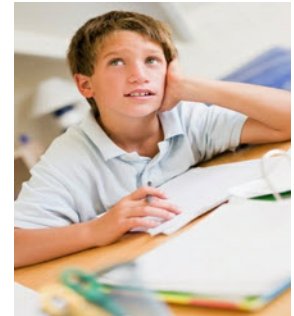

A little look into 4th grade.....

"Conjunction Junction, what's your function?" Our dear fourth graders have been learning the usages of and differences between subordinate and coordinate conjunctions, the power of a well-placed interjection, and how personification can make one's writing more dramatic and relatable. Even when they refuse to eat their vegetables at dinner, you can trust that they've been learning the importance of a balanced diet during their school hours, and take the time to reinforce the roles that nutrients, proteins, carbohydrates, fats, vitamins, minerals and fibers play in our bodies.
